

Setting Up Redirects

Redirect visitors from one URL to another using cPanel domain redirects.

Domain redirects send visitors from one address to another — useful when renaming pages, moving domains, or forwarding old URLs.

Create a redirect

1. Go to **Domains → Redirects**.
2. Choose the redirect type: **Permanent (301)** or **Temporary (302)**.
3. Select the domain and enter the path to redirect from (for example /old-page or leave blank for the entire domain).
4. Enter the destination URL in the **Redirects to** field.
5. Choose whether to redirect with or without **www**.
6. Click **Add**.

When to use each type

- **301 Permanent** — tells search engines the page has moved permanently; use for domain migrations.
- **302 Temporary** — use for short-term redirects such as maintenance pages.

Test redirects in a private browser window after saving to confirm they work as expected.
