

Creating and Managing Subdomains

Create subdomains such as `blog.example.com` and point them to the correct folder.

Subdomains let you run separate sites under the same main domain — for example `shop.example.com` or `blog.example.com`.

Create a subdomain

1. Go to **Account Manager → Subdomain Management**.
2. Select the parent domain.
3. Enter the subdomain label (for example `blog`).
4. Set the document root. DirectAdmin creates a folder under your domain by default.
5. Click **Create**.

Manage existing subdomains

From the same page you can change the document root or delete a subdomain. Deleting removes the associated directory unless you relocate files first.

DNS note

Subdomains usually work automatically on DanumHost nameservers. If you use external DNS, add an **A record** for the subdomain pointing to your server IP.
