Approved in April 2016 the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) is a significant legislative change in Europe relating to the data protection laws since the EU Data Protection Directive 95/46/EC which was introduced in 1995.

The EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) extends the scope of the EU data protection law to all foreign companies processing data in the EU residents. The GDPR also defines a new set of "digital rights" for EU citizens. Here at DanumHost Limited we support GDPR and well endeavour to ensure all our services comply with its provisions by the 25th of May 2018.
