

Setting Up Site Redirects

Redirect visitors from one URL to another using DirectAdmin site redirection.

Site redirects send visitors from one address to another — useful when renaming pages, moving domains, or forwarding old URLs.

Create a redirect

1. Go to **Account Manager → Site Redirection**.
2. Select the domain you want to redirect from.
3. Enter the source path (for example `/old-page` or the entire domain).
4. Enter the destination URL.
5. Choose the redirect type: **301** (permanent) or **302** (temporary).
6. Save the redirect.

When to use each type

- **301 Permanent** — tells search engines the page has moved permanently; use for domain migrations.
- **302 Temporary** — use for short-term redirects such as maintenance pages.

Test redirects in a private browser window after saving to confirm they work as expected.
